Rubio® Monocoat Fumed

Rubio® Monocoat Fumed reacts with tannins normally found in Oak, Ash and some other species. Fumed has been developed to quickly mimic the fumed (aged grey) effect on wood without the harmful chemicals. The effect is entirely dependent on the tannin content of each individual piece of wood and is therefore highly variable

- 4. REMOVE ALL EXCESS OIL WITHIN 10-15 MINUTES.


